Please let me know your wishes in the matter. also Mr Blun far stated that a letter had been sent instructing me in regards to old property to be condemned. I did not receive that, nor an answer to one asking about house moving. I dont know what could have happened to the letters I made special inquiry at Post office for them. Others may have been sent that I never received. Blackmoon left about 53 head of cows and coloes. The ponies have not been gathered yet. \$15 cash is deposited at
